PARADE RULES/PARADE INFORMATION

1. Marshaling begins at 4:00p.m. Please report to PARADE MARSHALL the beginning of Greendale Road who will then point out your position on the map.
2. The parade will commence at 5:00PM on Cowichan Lake Road (Old Highway).
3. The PARADE MARSHALL has the authority to reject any entry, which does not comply with the regulations of the Cowichan Lake District Chamber of Commerce Santa PARADE.
4. Throwing articles of any form of substance from parade units is STRICTLY PROHIBITED.
5. All units are requested to disperse in the designated area.

SAFETY REGULATIONS

The following requirements are a must for a safer parade.

1. Good visibility for the driver, allowing the driver a minimum of 180 degree vision.
2. Good communication system between the driver and person on float.
3. Drivers **MUST** have a valid driver's license and be a competent float driver. **DRIVERS SUSPECTED OF BEING IMPAIRED WILL NOT BE ALLOWED IN THE PARADE.**
4. Floats must be decorated with fire retardant materials. All exhaust pipes must be protected from decorations.
5. Persons riding on the float must be restrained with the use of seatbelts. No person is to be wired on or tied in a manner,
6. Fire extinguisher must be carried on all floats.
7. If an entry breaks down or has to stop, please move to the side of the road in order to keep the parade running smoothly.
8. All animals in the parade must be kept under control at all times. **The entry must provide their own CLEAN UP unit.**
9. Please refrain from throwing articles of any form, especially candy your from parade unit.
10. **Alcohol is STRICTLY PROHIBITED**
