### 2019 Island Savings “Business/Organization of the Year” Award

All Business/Organizations and citizens residing in the Cowichan Lake Area are eligible to nominate a business or organization

This award will recognize a **Chamber Member business/organization** that has made an outstanding contribution to the community.

**Nomination requirements are as follows:**

- good corporate citizenship through active participation in business and community events is essential
- the business/organization has the ability to create employment and generate income
- the business/organization promotes economic welfare
- the business/organization rewards its employees and the community at large with a sound reputation of providing quality service.



### 2019 Country Grocer Excellence in Customer Service “Employee of the Year” Award

This award will recognize an **employee of a Chamber Member business/organization** who consistently offers exceptional customer service.

**Nomination requirements are as follows:**

- good performance, attention to quality workmanship and service
- this person is considered a role model within his or her respective industry
- this person will have performed their job to such a level that their efforts have not only assisted revenues but also have enriched the lives of their customers and co-workers
- this person always goes the extra mile to serve the customer and is a strong team player

## Cowichan Lake District Chamber of Commerce Community Award

### 2019 “Citizen of the Year Award”

All citizens residing in the Cowichan Lake Area are eligible for: “Citizen of the Year Award”

**Criteria for the Citizen of the Year Award:**

- Awarded to an individual who has spearheaded, organized or carried through a project that has benefited the community as a whole during 2019.

### 2019 Nichole Stock Community Service Award

All citizens residing in the Cowichan Lake Area are eligible for

“Nichole Stock Community Service Award”

**Criteria for the Nichole Stock Community Service Award:**

- An individual who has exemplified volunteerism;
- Who has served the community unselfishly on an ongoing basis in 2019; and
- Who has **not** received any remuneration for the volunteer activity for which the award is given

### 2019 Youth of the Year Award

All Citizens 24yrs of age or younger residing in the Cowichan Lake Area are eligible for “Youth of the Year Award”

**Criteria for the Youth of the Year Award:**

- Must be a member of our community who has had a special impact in our society through their volunteer activities during 2019
- This person will have acted for the good of others, and has demonstrated exemplary leadership and mentoring skills
- The individual has shown a continuing and active interest in the people of Cowichan Lake and surrounding area.
